## Your Scottish Itinerary:

April 12: USA/Edinburgh. Fly transatlantic overnight from Chicago to Edinburgh, Scotland. Dinner provided on flight.

April 13: Enjoy your Edinburgh introduction while transferring to your Edinburgh Hotel.

April 14: City tour of Edinburgh where you will appreciate the contrast between 18th century Georgian "New Town" and the medieval "Old Town". Experience the Royal Mile, Palace of Holyrood House, Edinburgh Castle which houses the Scottish Crown Jewels and the Stone of Destiny. You can also visit the private apartments of St. Margaret's Chapel, and The Abbey.

April 15: Edinburgh/Falkland/Pitlochry. Take in the impressive Scottish Highlands. Today and over the coming days, explore some of the filming locations of the popular Starz fantasy series, *Outlander*. Head to picturesque Falkland where one of *Outlander's* first scenes was filmed, Falkland's Palace, Scone Palace.

April 16: Today you will travel north towards Inverness, stopping in Nairn where you visit Cawdor Castle. Explore Clava Cairns which lies above the River Nairn, inspiration for Craigh na Dun in *Outlander*. See the "Split Stone" through which Claire Randall might have tumbled in 1743. On to Culloden Battlefield for it's 271st anniversary of the failed Jacobite upraising.

April 17: Loch Ness & The Isle of Skye. This morning we'll travel to Clansman Harbor where we board a Jacobite Cruise to Urquhart Castle, See Eilean Donan Castle which is the setting for many movies including *Outlander*. This evening enjoy dinner and overnight in the Isle of Skye area.

April 18: Isle of Skye/Fort William. Today you will have a full day of sightseeing around Isle of Skye. Visit Armadale Castle, learning the story of Clan Donald. A short ferry ride from Armadale to the mainland brings you to Mallaig. Dinner & overnight in the Fort William area.

April 19: Fort William/Doune/Glasgow: Your first stop will be at Doune Castle. Both Robert the Bruce and William "Braveheart" Wallace made a name for themselves here. It plays a staring role in the *Outlander* as the Castle Leoch, home to Colum MacKenzie and his clan. Continue to Glengoyne Distillery including a whisky tasting. This evening you will be free to explore Glasgow.

April 20: Full day at leisure in Glasgow or an optional round of golf.

April 21: Transfer to Glasgow airport for your return flight to the US.
