ITINERARY 9 DAYS / 8 NIGHTS

DAY 1 LAS VEGAS

THE MIRAGE.

Transfer from Las Vegas Airport to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore and enjoy all that Las Vegas has to offer on your own.

DAY 2 LAS VEGAS TO BRYCE CANYON VIA ZION BEST WESTERN PLUS.

Travel across the Nevada Desert and visit Utah's oldest and most famous **Zion National Park** to admire massive 2,000-foot high formations and towers, the Mt. Carmel Tunnel, Zion Canyon and the Virgin River. Lunch will be on your own today. Later in the afternoon, travel through Zion Tunnel to **Bryce Canyon National Park** for an evening view. After checking in at the hotel just outside the park, enjoy some wonderful western food and entertainment at Ebenezer's Barn and Grill. Later tonight, join the group for a private Stargazing Experience with local astronomers to explore the wonders of the night sky and our universe. Bryce Canyon is designated as a Dark Skies Reserve and is one of the best places to stargaze in the U.S. (D)

DAY 3 BRYCE CANYON TO PAGE VIA GRAND CANYON

LAKE POWELL RESORT.

Return to **Bryce Canyon National Park** for a morning view. The vibrant colors and unearthly shapes spark the imagination of both young and old. A stop will be made to have lunch on your own before entering **Grand Canyon National Park North Rim**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This 1.2-million-acre national park hosts a wonderful variety of wildlife and scenic wonders. Enjoy some free time at Grand Canyon Lodge to get a snack, explore and walk out to Bright Angel Point. Later in the afternoon, take a scenic drive and travel through Marble Canyon and pass Vermillion Cliffs to Lake Powell Resort where you will spend the night. This evening, enjoy a group dinner with a wonderful view of Lake Powell. (B, D)

DAY 4 PAGE

LAKE POWELL RESORT.

This morning, tour through Antelope Canyon to admire its mysterious and haunting beauty. A tour to this awe-inspiring sculpture set in stone is a must for amateur and professional photographers alike. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Powell and see the contrast of the red rock walls and emerald blue waters. A visit to Glen Canyon Dam Visitors Center included for insight into the engineering marvel that creates this amazing oasis in the desert. There will be an optional short hike to Horseshoe Bend, followed by an evening at leisure. Lunch and dinner will be on your own today. (B)

DAY 5 PAGE TO MOAB VIA MONUMENT VALLEY ELEMENT MOAB.

Depart Lake Powell and travel to Monument Valley, a sacred place to the Navajo. Your Navajo guide will take you for a scenic tour of the area to see the sights, experience the culture and traditions. Then, enjoy a lunch at historic Goulding's Lodge. In the afternoon, travel north to Moab. This evening is free to relax and explore on your own. (B, L)



DAY 6 MOAB ELEMENT MOAB.

Tour the highlights of **Arches National Park**. The unique geology of the area created the highest concentration of natural arches in the world with over 2,000 named arches within the park boundary. You will visit the park's highlights including Balance Rock, the Windows and Delicate Arch Viewpoint. After the tour, enjoy free time to explore Moab and have lunch on your own. In the afternoon, join the group for a Jet Boat Ride on the mighty Colorado River through spectacular red rock canyons and learn about the river's ecosystem, geology and history. Enjoy dinner with a million-dollar view at the Sunset Grill. (B. D)

DAY 7 MOAB TO GLENWOOD SPRINGS HOTEL TBC.

This morning transfer to **Canyonlands National Park** to visit the Island in the Sky District including the Mesa Arch and Grandview Point. Next, take a scenic drive to **Dead Horse Point State Park** for a picnic lunch and one of the most spectacular scenes in the southwest. You will see the expanse of Canyonlands National Park stretching to the south and the mighty Colorado River 2,000 feet below. In the afternoon, board the **Rocky Mountaineer** train. Cross the Utah-Colorado border with stunning mountain views in the background before arriving in the resort town of Glenwood Springs. Today's dinner* will be served on the train. Overnight in Glenwood Springs. Hotel to be confirmed 30 days prior to stay. (B, L, D) *Dinner on the train includes alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages.

DAY 8 GLENWOOD SPRINGS TO DENVER THE RALLY.

Depart Glenwood Springs and continue your journey onboard **Rocky Mountaineer**. Cross the Continental Divide as you take in the spectacular views of rugged canyons and Colorado River before arriving at the vibrant city of Denver. Breakfast* and lunch* will be served on the train. Transfer to your Denver hotel and enjoy free time to explore Denver on your own. The LoDo district, with wonderful shops and restaurants, is within walking distance of your hotel. (B, L) *Meals on the train include alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages
